

# VintageMac's S Emblems



The stock Honda "H" emblem is plastic and attached with double-sided tape and two pins/keepers that go through two holes in the trunk and front bumper.

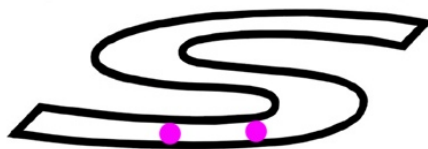
Remove the keepers from the plastic pins. Then using dental floss, "saw" through the double-sided tape to remove the emblem from the paint.

With your finger, gently rub off the remaining tape.

Clean and wax the area to remove any left-over residue from the old tape.

Note that there is a TOP and BOTTOM for the new stainless steel S emblem. The arm of the S that is widest is the bottom.

The emblem was designed to completely cover the 2 **holes** in the hood/trunk. The wider, bottom arm of the S emblem should cover these holes ↴



Press the emblem firmly in place.
